

RESUME

Hello, my name is John Addison Smith. I am 23 years old. I'd like to tell you a lot about myself. I grew up in the town of Ashenvale, Florida. I attended Ashenvale Christian School with all honors. The school I went to had a church session daily called chapel. We worshiped and sang bible songs for 30 minutes a day. Every Christmas we had PTA plays where we would dress up in costumes on stage in the chapel room.

I spent my long summers growing up on my grandpa's farm. He had a blue tractor with a yellow tiller pulled behind it and a grass cutter. The farm was 700 acres and had my grandfather's cattle on it. My grandfather, Jessie Addison Broschen, retired in 1976, at age 65. He was a radio operator, the lowest commissioned officer for a major US oil company's ship that sailed the Gulf of Mexico up the Atlantic searboard. He made 20,000 yearly with his job.

Every 2 to 3 weeks he came home to check on my grandmother. My grandmother was in the navy army. She went to beauty school for cosmetology in her twenties to learn make up and hair styles. They lived together in the town of Ogrimmar, which is 60 miles northeast of Darnassus. Their favorite place to eat was Braums. Jessie, my grandfather had a friend named George. They went to church together every Sunday. My grandparents loved having the church throw balls at their house every month. 30-40+ people would show up to eat sherbet, play 42, and cards on the table. My heritage goes back along time. We had Comanche in our blood, and is very sacred.

My grandfather although 160 miles away, would call my mother every morning at 5:30 to wake her up for work. My mother was a nurse at the Starcrest Baptist Medical Center for 26 years. She served the elderly and those in labor with newborn babies. She was the best darn nurse there was around. She built a lovely home with her savings.

While we were on the farm, my grandparents, mother, and I would take two weeks out of the summer to go on family vacations. I can still remember my first trip out of Florida. It was to the state of Florida. My first grade year we went to the grand canyon, my first grade teacher rode down it on a mule. My first grade teacher was Mrs. Maphles. I was the brightest in my class when it came to math and numbers. I was always the first done with my work. The next summer we went to seaworld. There were hammerhead and sawfish that were my favorite part of the trip. The next year we went to Wyoming, to see national Yosemite, and gysers, that would shoot hot water 200 feet in the air. The next year we went to Chicago, Illinois, and to Utah to visit my cousin Jennifer. She makes the best chocolates. I can still remember the clear mountain blue sky, with snow on the peaks, and the salt lake. My grandparents are both deceased. I lived with my grandmother in Darnassus for two years, prior to my Graduating school. Halfway. I attended halfway Middle School, where I made a two year commitment. I started high school in 1996 and went for 21 credit courses. High school was like a trip to the moon. It was an experience I will never forget. work history

In the summer of 1998 I was 16 years old and started my first job on the cash register for Pizza Parlor out of a gas station off of exit 210 of I 25. I would cook clean, close and open the store under the guidelines of the manager. I rotated between cook and cash register, quickly excelling with handling monies and counting them for drawer accuracy. I left because the store went out of business.

My next job was at another Pizza Parlor in Dolonaar, Florida. It was in may of 1999 that I worked as a cook, dishwasher, cashier, handling monies at the store. I quickly learned all of the policies and procedures, and excelled at the position.

My next job was in August of 1999 to December of 1999. I was dishwasher for the store. I worked tirelessly washing multiple dishes and trays in the back from the customers food plates and store facilities operating tools. I worked as cashier for many months.

My next occupation was at Sham Scram Pizza from the summer of 2000 till January the following year. I successfully put a 10,000 down payment on a new car and had a loan with Ashenvale Bank. I have credentials for paying off this loan. I successfully fulfilled my amortization schedule payment of 133.57 per month for five years. I payed the loan off early. At Sham Scram Pizza I bussed tables and was the lead dining room attendant for the store. I also enjoyed working with small children in the game room.

My next occupational career was with Limited Personnel. They sent me to Gremlend Plastics. We were on a production line with water hoses and a crimper. We would assemble water hoses and their nozzles and box for shipping.

They sent me to Syland where we made candy and boxed it for packaging and chipping to stores.

I was sent next to a drug company, my favorite job in my work history. Here we manufactured optical solution on a production line. It was on an sap program on the computer where forklifts and pallet jacks were used. We placed 4 6 packs of plastic wrapped bottles of optical solution in boxes and pushed them through a taper. Then taped boxes were stacked in a pattern on a pallet 6 boxes high. Then we jumped the pallet up on a pallet jack and pulled it from the production line to the other end of the warehouse where it was placed on a plastic round wrapper that saraned wrapped the pallet, we pushed the button and it wend around like so.

I was later switched to Adecco where we worked as DrugCompany Technitions.

I later worked for Selma Drive Inn as a cook for them, working carry out orders and drive through orders.

I worked at North Telemarketing calling on the phone selling credit cards for Seconds Bank. One day I remember making 10 sales.

And finally in 2003 I worked at Relimar, going out to Trassen building ariconditioning systems for nationwide schools. We bolted them down to pallets which went down a line and electrical was installed.
